

## **Burton's Dive Service – Conditional Restrictions for Junior Scuba Diver Certification**

As per NAUI (National Association of Underwater Instructors) Standards and Policies, Junior Scuba Diver certification can be issued to persons aged 12-14 years. The following conditional restrictions apply to persons receiving Junior Certification:

- The parent or guardian and Junior diver agree that the Junior diver will dive with a certified adult diver (18 years of age or over) of the parent's or guardian's selection.
- The parent or guardian and Junior diver agree that the Junior diver will limit diving depth to 60 feet (18m) or less.
- By signing the Junior certification card, the parent or guardian agrees to be responsible for the selection of the certified adult buddy and the limitation of diving depth.
- To remove the Junior cards conditional requirements, a new card must be requested by an active-status NAUI Instructor once the Junior diver attains the age of 15 years for full certification. There will be an upgrade fee for the new card, and copies of the Junior diver's dive logs may be requested.
